Some Things We Learned While Restoring a 1979 Mustang Pace Car....Part 3 of 3

This is a rather interesting compilation of information assembled by past MCT president Bob Powell and his son Jonathan who served as our club secretary. Bob moved about 4 years ago back to Alabama and resides outside of Birmingham. Several of us were in Birmingham for a show a few years ago and Bob had us over for breakfast to see his place and his garage. Bob is an excellent restorer and struggles for space in his crowded garage. LOL. The article is simply notes on the restoration of their 79 Pace Car, which incidentally got started several years ago with another Pace Car acquisition at auction held at our annual show at MOSI.

The interior screw kit comes with twice as many screws as needed; **don't be alarmed. They must put every screw needed for any model** from 1979 to 1993 so you will have several left over.



I cross threaded the high pressure power steering hose when installing it on the steering gear box; another area that is hard to get to. I was pretty upset about this however by lightly filing the first few rows of thread that were damaged, I was able to install correctly. The seal is an O-ring at the bottom of the fitting so the cross threading and correcting did not affect the sealing.

We installed a medium-rise, aluminum, 4 bbl intake manifold which had 6 threaded openings for water ports, vacuum points, etc. Unfortunately, I only installed 5 plugs; I missed one that goes in the intake horizontal under the back of the carburetor. Of course, we had a vacuum leak on start up but I did not realize it right away and the engine would not idle. We checked and rechecked timing, dwell, etc. until we started looking for vacuum leaks. Lesson – check and recheck for all openings on a new intake manifold.

Since we installed an after-market, aluminum intake, we had to purchase a new Holley carburetor. I installed it on our 68 Mustang to just make sure it ran correctly and had some break-in time. This just eliminates one issue if you have a start up problem.

On Fox Body cars, make sure the sun roof drains are not clogged; use air pressure to blow out any debris in the lines.

One strange thing we found on this car is one of the heater hoses is about 1 inch diameter on the water pump and 5/8 inch on the heater. I **don't know why. I think there is supposed to be an adapter but we did not have it on our car so we had to make one from pipe fittings and adapters.**

Since we removed what was left of the smog equipment, we installed a smog eliminator pulley. Although they are sold to replace the smog pump exactly, we had to adjust the mounting to align with the belt system.

The rubber fuel line from the body to the fuel pump runs real close to **the header on the driver's side so we wrapped the fuel line with heat resistant tape we bought at NAPA.**

The dash and console has a silver accent line along the border of the plastic molding. Krylon ShortCuts Paint pen is perfect for repainting this. Basically you just patiently follow the outline with the pen.
